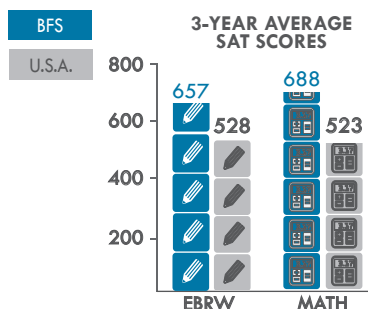

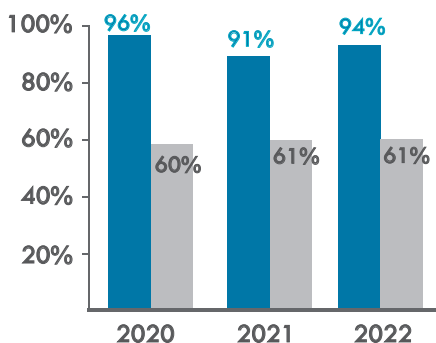

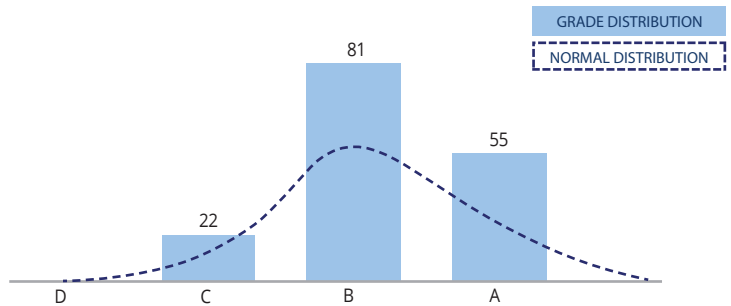
MISSION STATEMENT
